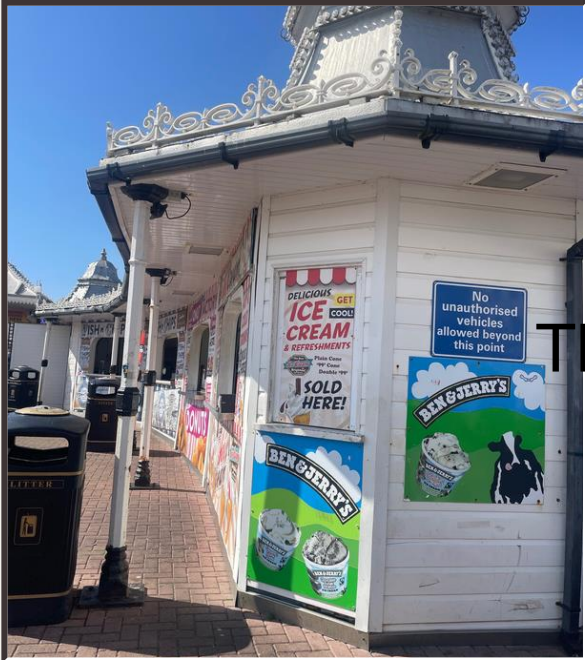
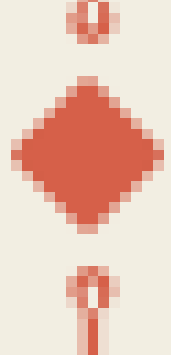
Friday Afternoon:

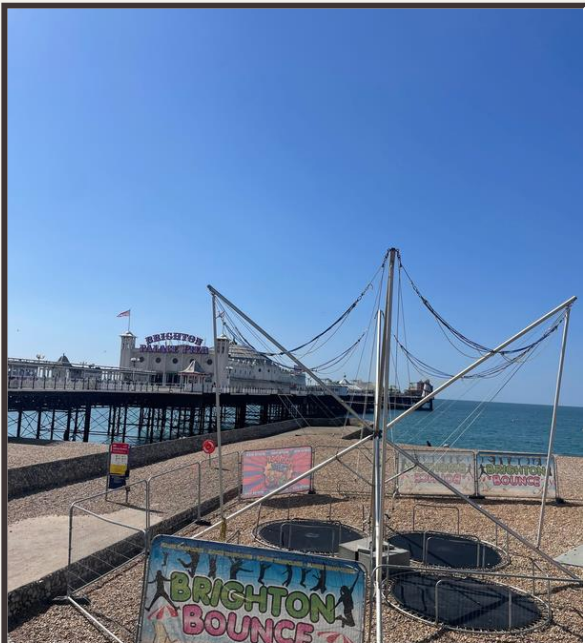
